Dear Parents and Carers,

We have planned our Sports Event Day for **Tuesday 11th July 2017** - weather permitting! It would be great to see you. Please find the details below:

Nursery and Reception

*Nursery and Reception events will begin at 9.30a.m. We would like to invite **all Nursery pupils at this time.** Tuesday Morning Nursery (Group A) and both Reception classes will need to be dropped off and registered by staff as normal please. Parents of these groups/classes can make their way to the field after drop off. Staff will then escort the children to the sports field. Reception pupils will change into their PE kits in school. It would be very helpful if **all Nursery children** come along to the session in a PE kit/appropriate clothing and shoes please as this will save time.*

*Nursery children who do not usually attend on a Tuesday morning (Group B) do not need to arrive for registration in the morning – parents of these children please head straight to the field for **9.20am** where Nursery staff will be waiting to meet you and your child.*

*Tuesday morning nursery parents (Group A) may wish to take their child with them at the end of the events. This will be fine but in order to ensure safety, these children will need to return to the classroom first so that the staff can keep accurate records. Group B children will need to leave site with parents when the sports events have completed please. The **Tuesday afternoon Nursery session will be open as normal.***

*The activities will be arranged as a circuit, parents will then need to follow their child's class. There will be plenty of staff to co-ordinate the event outside. **It is anticipated that Nursery and Reception will complete their races by 10.30am.***

Years One and Two

The sports events for years 1 and 2 will begin at 10.45am. Access to the playground/field area will not be granted until 10.35am. Years One and Two will move around a circuit and you may then follow each class. It is anticipated that these year groups will finish at approximately 11.45am.

Years Three and Four

The events for these year groups will begin after lunch at 1.10pm and end at 2.10pm. Access to the playground/field area will not be granted until 1pm. There will be six activities setup. Your child will be placed into 1 of 6 groups. Details of groups and starting activity will be sent in the next week. They will compete against other pupils in their year group.

Years Five and Six

The events for these year groups will begin at 2.20pm and end at 3.20pm. Access to the playground/field area will not be granted until 2.20pm. There will be six activities setup. Your child will be placed into 1 of 6 groups. Details of groups and starting activity will be sent in the next week They will compete against other pupils in their year group.

Please can all children have their **PE kits** in school, (except Nursery). They will also need their **water bottle**. If the children would like to bring an **extra** drink that day, then they may. (**Please avoid fizzy drinks**). If the weather is hot, can you please ensure the children have **sun-cream** on their skin and a **hat** of some sort.

The gate for entry and exit for the whole day will be the gate located on Winsford Avenue. We will be providing some chairs for spectators, but if you want a guaranteed seat - then feel free to bring a folding one. Please note that it is ever so tricky to try to ensure that siblings in the same phases participate at different times. So unless you can bring along other family members you may have to divide yourself between events!

If the weather is very wet or has been awful just prior to the day then we will cancel, as the field needs to be dry in order to avoid accidents. If we have to cancel, we will let you know as early as possible on the day via your mobile phone.
