Staff are looking forward to a lovely summer term with your children.

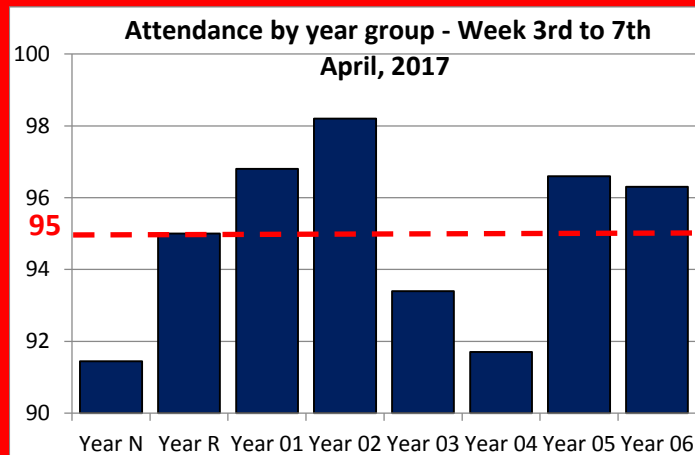
