### Moving On day

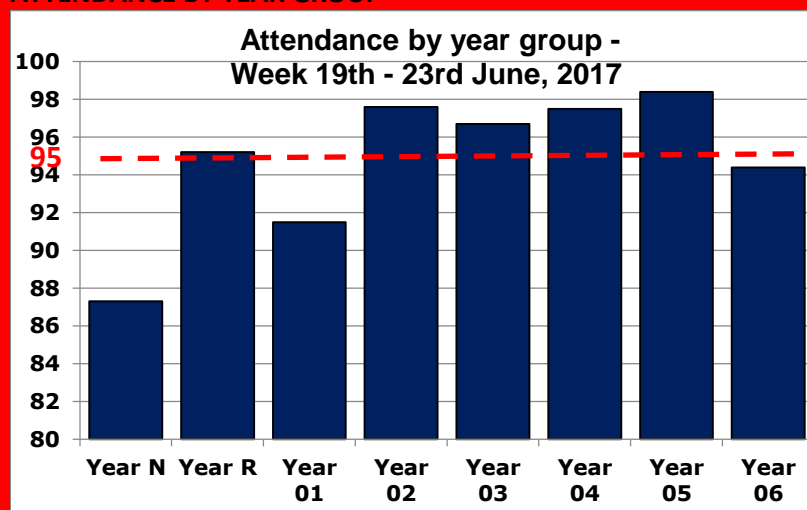
