Dear Parents/Carers

Skern Lodge Residential Visit – Friday 22nd June – Monday 25th June 2018

The above residential visit is fast approaching and some final information is detailed below.

Children should arrive at school for 7.45am on Friday morning; the coach will be leaving school at approximately 8.15am from Allesley Old Road. Pupils can come to school in non uniform, these clothes need to be comfortable for the journey. Suitcases/bags are to be dropped off on the grass outside the KS2 Hall next to the fence. We would be very grateful for any help to get the suitcases/bags on the coach.

Staff accompanying the trip will be available in the hall should you wish to chat briefly to them. All medications are to be handed to **Mrs Lindsay**. These should be clearly named and handed in with the completed medicine request form (attached).

As a reminder children can bring money if they wish to purchase items from the tuck and souvenir shop. Please ensure the money for the tuck shop does not exceed £6.00. The named wallet/purse is to be handed to **Mr Tarn** in the hall on Friday morning. Please can the amount of money for the tuck shop and for souvenirs be identified in/on the named wallet/purse - e.g. £3.00 for the tuck shop and £10.00 for souvenirs. **(Hoodies are £22.00, T-Shirts are £6.50 and other souvenirs range from 50p to £5.00).**

Pupils will need a packed lunch and drinks for the journey.

When we have arrived at Skern Lodge, a text message will be sent to parents. Please make sure that the school is aware of any change of mobile phone numbers.

The weather forecast is mixed. Please include a cap or hat and sun cream just in case!

We should arrive back at school on Monday at approximately 5.00pm. A text message will be sent to confirm we have returned. If this changes, then we will update you accordingly

As your child is likely to be tired following the trip, they do not need to be in school at the usual time on Tuesday morning (this won't be classed as an absence). We would however expect all children to be in by 12.00 noon **at the latest**. If your child usually has a school dinner, then this will be ordered for them.
