Ben - 5G: his enthusiasm, fantastic use of imagination and increased confidence when writing!

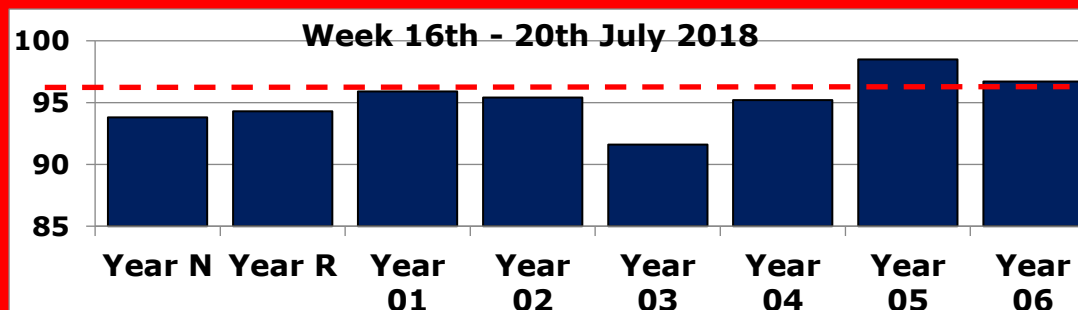
Thomas - 5P: the confidence and ability displayed during his keyboard performance
